Nevada's Universal Cannabis Symbol



To assist in the identification of products that contain THC, the above symbol must be stamped, molded, or printed with color contrast on each individual and single-serving of edible cannabis products beginning on or before January 1, 2019 (R092-17, Sec 229). Edible cannabis products that are impractical to stamp or mold with a symbol including, but not limited to, bulk goods or powders, must be packaged in a child-resistant container in individual servings containing not more than 10 milligrams of THC. Edible liquid products that are packaged in child-resistant containers also do not need to be stamped or molded. Establishments may include the number of milligrams (example: 10 mg) next to the symbol as long as the symbol and milligrams are readable, clear and unambiguous in accordance with S8344 & NRS 453A.360. The milligrams may not appear within the symbol, as the symbol may not be modified in any way. Any other means of demarking the edibles must be approved by the Cannabis Compliance Board by writing to AuditInspections@ccb.nv.gov
