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Nevada Cannabis Compliance Board Launches July 1: 'What to Expect'

On July 1, the Nevada Cannabis Compliance Board (CCB) becomes fully authorized and takes the reigns on the state's cannabis industry.

To aid in a smooth transition, the CCB has compiled updated information and answers to FAQs, regarding new procedures to obtain/renew agent cards and licenses.

Effective July 1, 2020:

I. CCB: Who are we and what do we do?

The Nevada Cannabis Compliance Board governs the state's cannabis industry through strict regulation of all areas of its licensing and operations, protecting the public health and safety of our citizens and visitors while holding cannabis licensees to the highest ethical standards.

V. Cannabis Agent Cards: What's new?

- a. To obtain a Cannabis Agent Card, applications may only be submitted through the [online portal](#) or by mail. No in-person applications will be accepted.
- b. Effective July 1st, Cannabis Agent Cards issued after July 1st will be valid for two years.
- c. Application Fees will increase from \$75.00 to \$150.00.
- d. Applications received after July 1st will be subject to the fee increase. Applications received or postmarked by June 30th will be processed and valid for 1 year.

VI. License Renewals & Applications

- a. License Renewals may be submitted by mail, through Accela (online portal) or in-person by appointment only.
- b. When offices are scheduled to reopen, an online scheduling link will be sent out.

VII. Cannabis Fees (License Renewals, Civil Penalties and/or Time and Effort)

- a. Fees will be accepted by the Cannabis Compliance Board ONLY. The Department of Taxation will cease accepting payments effective July 1, 2020.
- b. Cash Payments over \$2000.00 will be accepted by appointment only. Check payments must be mailed to: Cannabis Compliance Board, P.O. Box 1948, Carson City, NV 89701

- c. Walk-in's are not allowed.

VIII. Cannabis Taxes (Wholesale Marijuana Tax, Retail Marijuana Tax)

- a. All cannabis (marijuana) tax returns and payment should continue to be remitted to the *Department of Taxation*.
