Subject: Notice of Hearing for Consideration of Proposed Amendments and/or Additions to the Nevada Cannabis Compliance Board Regulations 5.120, 5.130, and 6.025

The Nevada Cannabis Compliance Board (CCB) will hold a public hearing for the purpose of considering the adoption, amendment or repeal of the regulation(s) stated below.

In compliance with the Governor's Emergency Directive #006 (dated March 22, 2020), and Emergency Directive #029 (dated July 31, 2020), the consideration of the adoption, amendment, or repeal of the regulations stated below during the meeting of the CCB may be conducted by means of electronic communications. For Possible Action

Purpose: The need and purpose of the proposed changes to the NCCRs is to clarify details such as: who must apply for cannabis establishment registration cards; and assessments for time and effort to oversee the cannabis industry.

Regulation 5.120: An amendment clarifying who must apply for a cannabis establishment registration card when a person owns less than 5 percent of a cannabis establishment.

Regulation 5.130: An amendment clarifying who must apply for a cannabis establishment registration card for a cannabis executive.

Regulation 6.025: An amendment clarifying when the Board can collect an assessment from each cannabis establishment for the time and effort attributed to the oversight of the industry.

The proposed changes to the regulations will be considered by the CCB in accordance with the provisions of NRS 678A.460(1)(c), which provides that on the date and at the time and place designated, any interested person or their duly authorized representative, or both, shall be afforded the opportunity to present statements, arguments or contentions in writing, with or without the opportunity to present the same orally. IF THE FEBRUARY CCB MEETING IS HELD BY MEANS OF ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION, ANY PERSON DESIRING TO PRESENT STATEMENTS, ARGUMENTS OR CONTENTIONS CONCERNING THE PROPOSED REGULATION CHANGES MUST PROVIDE SUCH IN WRITING TO THE EXECUTIVE ASSISTANT AT regulations@ccb.gov by 9 P.M. on the day prior to the meeting. Written public comment received after 9:00 p.m. the day before (or during the open meeting) will be included in the record as reasonable, in accordance with Governor's Directive #006 as applicable by Directive #029.

These items will be heard by the CCB at the February 23, 2021 meeting, and may be continued and heard at subsequent meetings of the CCB as required to effectuate the above-stated purposes.
