Good Morning, my name is Cristina Ulman, I am the President and Co-Founder of the Chamber of Cannabis, Nevada's most diverse industry trade organization comprised of business, professional and activists working to build a more conscientious, inclusive and thriving industry.

I wanted to use my time today to follow up on the suggested solutions and revisions that were offered and discussed during the industry round table that was held just less than 60 days ago.

Along with approximately 15 other industry professionals, Chamber Board Member, Davin Homan and myself shared numerous solutions that would help alleviate unnecessary costs for cultivators, producers, retailers, consumers and patients. Ultimately making it easier to operate in Nevada and help support the struggling legal market.

A few of the suggestions we asked the board to take into consideration are the following...

- Revising Fair Market Value Calculations
- Reducing time and effort billing to no longer include research time by the investigators
- Revising testing from 5lbs to a minimum of 25lbs
- Revising numerous packaging regulations to reduce waste especially in single use plastics that are ending up in Nevada's landfill and littered throughout our streets.
- Revising the pre-roll tax
- Revising the acceptable microbial levels to increase quality of flower
- Creating a more collaborative resource line for the industry to have as a tool to ensure regulations are followed correctly.

We respectfully ask for the board to consider revising these issues as soon as possible. Our coalition will gladly continue to work with the CCB to provide insight on matters that we see an opportunity to improve.
