II. Proposed Amendments and Additions to Nevada Cannabis Compliance Regulations:
Packaging, Labeling and Advertising

A. **Regulation 6.** (for discussion only)

1. NCCR 6.010 Establishment of maximum allowable quantity of cannabis products a person may possess for purposes of exemption from state or local prosecution.
2. NCCR 6.085 Required security measures, equipment and personnel; location of outdoor cultivation facility must allow for response by local law enforcement.
3. NCCR 6.120 Restrictions on advertising; required posting of signs in cannabis sales facility.

B. **Regulation 7.** (for discussion only)

1. NCCR 7.025 Prohibition on sale that exceeds maximum usable quantity of cannabis.
2. NCCR 7.030 Products required to be offered for sale; restrictions on sale of other products; restrictions on advertising.

C. **Regulation 12.** (for discussion only)

1. NCCR 12.010 Requirements for single packages.
2. NCCR 12.015 Requirements for edible cannabis products, products in solid or liquid form, usable cannabis and concentrated cannabis or cannabis products.
3. NCCR 12.030 Cannabis cultivation facility: Required labeling before sale of cannabis to another cannabis establishment.
4. NCCR 12.035 Cannabis production facility: Required labeling of cannabis products before sale to retail store.
5. NCCR 12.040 Cannabis sales facility and cannabis consumption lounge: Required labeling of usable cannabis and single-use cannabis products.

6. NCCR 12.045 Cannabis sales facility and cannabis consumption lounge: Required labeling of cannabis products.
7. NCCR 12.050 Cannabis sales facility and cannabis consumption lounge: Required disclosures and warnings.
8. NCCR 12.070 Advertising of cannabis.

Comments by the public may be limited to three minutes as a reasonable time, place, and manner restriction, but may not be limited upon viewpoint. If a member of the public is unable to attend the meeting in person and would like to provide public comment during the meeting through remote appearance, they can submit a request via email before the scheduled meeting to regulations@ccb.nv.gov to receive instructions to join the meeting remotely. The CCB is not responsible for technical difficulties a member of the public may experience in connecting to the meeting remotely. Comments by the public may be emailed to regulations@ccb.nv.gov by 5:00 p.m. the day before the scheduled meeting and include the commenter's full name. Content may be redacted due to inappropriate language. All written public comments shall, in their entirety, be included as part of the public record. Prior to the commencement and conclusion of a contested case or a quasi-judicial proceeding that may affect the due process rights of an individual, the Board may refuse to consider public comment regarding the matter pursuant to NRS 233B.126 and NCCR 4.080. In the event technical difficulties prevent these proceedings from being broadcast, the CCB, at its discretion, may conduct the meeting without the proceedings being broadcast.
