Subject: Notice of Hearing for Consideration of Proposed Adoption, Amendment and/or Repeal of the Nevada Cannabis Compliance Regulations (NCCR) 1.069, 1.084, 1.112, 5.170, 5.175, 5.180, 5.190, 5.195, and 10.080.

The Nevada Cannabis Compliance Board (CCB) will hold a public hearing for the purpose of considering the adoption, amendment or repeal of the regulation(s) stated below.

For Possible Action

Purpose: The need and purpose of the proposed changes to the NCCR(s) is to establish regulations for Cannabis Receivers and to amend regulation to allow for composting.

Regulation 1.069: An addition of the definition of "Cannabis Receiver."

Regulation 1.084: An addition of the definition of "Disabled."

Regulation 1.112: An addition of the definition of "Incapacitated."

Regulation 5.170: An addition to allow for the death or incapacity of a cannabis establishment owner.

- Regulation 5.175: An addition to allow for the placement and appointment of a cannabis receiver.
- **Regulation 5.180:** An addition to detail the application and requirements for a cannabis receiver.

Regulation 5.190: An addition to detail the duties and responsibilities of a cannabis receiver.

Regulation 5.195: An addition to allow for a certificate of qualification for a cannabis receiver.

Regulation 10.080: An amendment to address the manner and method of waste disposal by composting.

The proposed changes to the regulation(s) will be considered by the CCB in accordance with the provisions of NRS 678A.460(1)(c), which provides that on the date and at the time and place designated, any interested person or their duly authorized representative, or both, shall be afforded the opportunity to present statements, arguments or contentions in writing, with or without the opportunity to present the same orally. Any person desiring to present statements, arguments, or contentions concerning the proposed regulation changes may provide such in writing to the Executive Assistant at regulations@ccb.nv.gov by 5 P.M. on the day prior to the meeting. If oral presentations are permitted, persons intending to make such presentations must be personally present at the public hearing. Allowances for remote appearance may be made for those with disabilities only, but such requests must be made at least eight calendar days prior to the meeting.

These item(s) will be heard by the CCB at the November 14, 2023, meeting, and may be continued and heard at subsequent meetings of the CCB as required to effectuate the above-stated purposes.
