CN is or was the holder of medical cultivation and production license nos. 66298101522105826229 and 93277852865535573437 (establishment identification nos. C095 P066). adult-use cultivation and and and production license nos. 42764648009006859903 and 68782695892471568312 (establishment identification nos. RC095 and RP066).

On or about December 20, 2022, the CCB filed a Complaint for Disciplinary Action against Respondent involving the licenses listed above. CN filed its Answer to the Complaint on or about January 23, 2023.

That the disciplinary matter is currently pending before Administrative Law Judge Amy Meyer, and a final prehearing conference is scheduled for April 8, 2024, with the final hearing to commence April 9, 2024, at 9:00 a.m.

CN voluntarily surrendered medical cultivation and production license nos. 66298101522105826229 and 93277852865535573437 (establishment identification nos. C095 and P066). and adult-use cultivation and production license 42764648009006859903 and 68782695892471568312 (establishment identification nos.

1 RC095 and RP066) on January 22, 2024. And the CCB issued its Order of Voluntary 2 Surrender on January 23, 2024. In exchange for the voluntary surrender of CN's licenses, 3 the CCB agreed to dismiss the disciplinary case.
