10 **STIPULATION AND ORDER TO DISMISS**

11 Petitioner Cannabis Compliance Board (“CCB” or “Petitioner”), by and through its
12 counsel of record, and Respondent CN Licenseco I, Inc. dba Flowerone (“CN” or
13 “Respondent”), by and through its counsel of record, stipulate and agree as follows:

14 CN is or was the holder of medical cultivation and production license nos.
15 66298101522105826229 and 93277852865535573437 (establishment identification nos.
16 C095 and P066), and adult-use cultivation and production license nos.
17 42764648009006859903 and 68782695892471568312 (establishment identification nos.
18 RC095 and RP066).

19 On or about December 20, 2022, the CCB filed a Complaint for Disciplinary Action
20 against Respondent involving the licenses listed above. CN filed its Answer to the
21 Complaint on or about January 23, 2023.

22 That the disciplinary matter is currently pending before Administrative Law Judge
23 Amy Meyer, and a final prehearing conference is scheduled for April 8, 2024, with the final
24 hearing to commence April 9, 2024, at 9:00 a.m.

25 CN voluntarily surrendered medical cultivation and production license nos.
26 66298101522105826229 and 93277852865535573437 (establishment identification nos.
27 C095 and P066), and adult-use cultivation and production license nos.
28 42764648009006859903 and 68782695892471568312 (establishment identification nos.

1 RC095 and RP066) on January 22, 2024. And the CCB issued its Order of Voluntary
2 Surrender on January 23, 2024. In exchange for the voluntary surrender of CN's licenses,
3 the CCB agreed to dismiss the disciplinary case.

4 CN acknowledges that neither the voluntary surrender of its licenses, nor the CCB's
5 election to forego further disciplinary action, precludes the Nevada Department of Taxation
6 from pursuing all available remedies to collect taxes owed.

7 IT IS SO STIPULATED this 23rd day of February 2024.




10 **ORDER OF DISMISSAL**
