

1 Pursuant to NCCR 4.135(1), on the record, Chair Guzmán-Fralick, Board Member
2 Douglas, and Board Member Young confirmed their review of the record through review of
3 these materials.

4 Pursuant to NCCR 4.135(2), CCB's counsel presented its disciplinary
5 recommendation to accept the Hearing Officer's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and
6 Recommendations for discipline. As noted, Respondent was not present at the Hearing.
7 Further, Board Member Douglas asked and received confirmation from CCB's counsel that,
8 as indicated in the Hearing Officer's Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law, and
9 Recommendation for Discipline, Respondent was sent notice on numerous occasions to his
10 address and email on file with the Board and he did not appear at any noticed events or
11 provide any notice or excuse for his non-appearances.

12 Based on the evidence and argument presented at the Hearing, the CCB enters the
13 following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order. Under Title 56 of the Nevada
14 Revised Statutes ("NRS") and Nevada Cannabis Compliance Board Regulations ("NCCR"),
15 the CCB has jurisdiction over this matter.

16 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

17 Based on a preponderance of the evidence in the record and testimony presented at
18 the Hearing and in November, the CCB voted 4-0 to find the factual allegations were proven
19 by a preponderance of the evidence and hereby accepts the Hearing Officer's factual
20 findings in Exhibit "1."

21 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

22 Based on the foregoing factual findings and the preponderance of the evidence, the
23 CCB voted 4-0 that the violations of law occurred and hereby accepts the Hearing Officer's
24 conclusions of law in Exhibit "1."

25 **ORDER REGARDING DISCIPLINE**

26 For good cause appearing to the CCB, by a 4-0 vote, the CCB accepts the Hearing
27 Officer's recommendation for discipline as to Respondent's cannabis establishment
28 registration agent cards for cultivation (# [REDACTED]) and production (# [REDACTED]) are

1 to be suspended for a period of nine (9) years and eleven (11) months from the date this
2 Order is executed.

3 IT IS SO ORDERED.
