**INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING A PETITION REQUESTING ADOPTION, AMENDMENT
OR REPEAL OF A REGULATION**

Per NCCR 4.145, any interested party may petition the Board to request the adoption, amendment or repeal of a regulation.

The request must be filed with the CCB Executive Director together with a nonrefundable filing fee of \$500.00.

THE PETITION MUST CONTAIN:

- The name, business address and telephone number of the petitioner;
- A statement of the substance or nature of the regulation, amendment or repeal requested;
- A statement identifying the specific regulation in question;
- A clearly drafted proposed new regulation or amendment to be drafted or a detailed statement of what regulation is to be repealed and why;
- A statement identifying the persons or groups who the petitioner believes will be affected by the proposed regulation change; and
- The signature of the petitioner or the petitioner's legal representative.

NOTE: Any interested party should review NCCR 4.145 in its entirety prior to submitting a petition to the Board.

TO SUBMIT PAYMENT:

All payments must be mailed to the CCB address below. It is important that payment includes only what is required below.

All payments must be in the form of a check, cashiers' check, or money order. All payments must be payable to the State of Nevada (DO NOT include the words "marijuana" or "cannabis" anywhere on your payment) and mailed to:
