The Agency will hold a workshop to solicit comments from interested parties regarding proposed changes to the permanent regulations of the Cannabis Compliance Board, LCB File No. TBD, which revises provisions governing proceedings before the Board, clarifies definitions, provides clarity to manufacturing, cultivation and laboratory standards, and other matters properly relating thereto.

II. Proposed Amendments and Additions to Nevada Cannabis Compliance Regulations

Regulations 6 through 15, including each subsection thereof, are open for public comment and suggested amendments. (Regulations 1 through 5, including each subsection thereof, will also be open for public comment and suggested amendments at a workshop dated December 2, 2025).

A. **Regulation 6. Production and Distribution of Cannabis:** Other than the specific regulations noted below, possible discussion of the requirements of maintaining cannabis onsite for any cannabis establishment (for discussion only)

1. NCCR 6.035. Confidentiality of name and other information of persons who facilitate or deliver services pursuant to Title 56 of NRS; exceptions.
2. NCCR 6.072. Training and instruction required before agent may begin work or service as a volunteer.
3. NCCR 6.075. Development, documentation and implementation of certain policies and procedures; maintenance and availability.
4. NCCR 6.080. Inventory control system; authorized sources for acquisition of cannabis and cannabis products; duties of establishment if loss incurred; maintenance and availability of documentation.
5. NCCR 6.085. Required security measures, equipment and personnel; location of outdoor cultivation facility must allow for response by local law enforcement.
6. NCCR 6.100. Quality assurance testing required before sale or transfer of products.
7. NCCR 6.120. Restrictions on advertising; required posting of signs in cannabis sales facility.

B. **Regulation 7. Cannabis Sales Facility:** Other than the specific regulations noted below, possible discussion of cannabis sales facility requirements for storing, selling and delivering cannabis (for discussion only)

1. NCCR 7.015. Duties of cannabis establishment agent before sale to consumer.

- C. **Regulation 8. Cannabis Cultivation Facility:** Possible discussion of cultivation licensing requirements, operational standards, and compliance expectations (for discussion only)
- D. **Regulation 9. Production of Cannabis Products:** Possible discussion of production facility requirements, standard operating procedures and sanitation methods (for discussion only)
- E. **Regulation 10. Minimum Good Manufacturing Practices for Cultivation and Preparation of Cannabis Products for Administration to Humans:** Other than the specific regulations noted below, possible discussion of the quality control requirements for handling of cannabis (for discussion only)
 - 1. NCCR 10.080. Cannabis establishment: Storage, management and disposal of waste.
- F. **Regulation 11. Cannabis Independent Testing Lab:** Possible discussion of laboratory requirements, necessary accreditations, operational standards, testing and compliance methods (for discussion only)
- G. **Regulation 12. Packaging and Labeling of Cannabis Products** Other than the specific regulations noted below, possible discussion of the requirements for proper packaging and labeling of cannabis (for discussion only)
 - 1. NCCR 12.010. Requirements for single packages.
 - 2. NCCR 12.015. Requirements for packaging cannabis, cannabis products and edible cannabis products.
 - 3. NCCR 12.070. Advertising of cannabis.
- H. **Regulation 13. Cannabis Distributors:** Possible discussion of wholesale transportation requirements, duties, storage, methods and amounts that may be transported (for discussion only)
- I. **Regulation 14. Licensee Workplace Requirements:** Possible discussion of policies, procedures and methods to ensure prohibition of workplace discrimination and harassment (for discussion only)
- J. **Regulation 15. Cannabis Consumption Lounge:** Possible discussion of the operational requirements of a cannabis consumption lounge (for discussion only)

The public is hereby noticed that items on this agenda are stacked. Items may be taken out of order, two or more agenda items may be combined for consideration, and/or at any time an agenda item may be removed from the agenda or discussion delayed.

The Cannabis Compliance Board (CCB) will take public comment on any matters within its jurisdiction, control, or advisory power. The Board is not permitted to deliberate or take action on any items raised during the public comment period until the matter itself has been specifically included on an agenda as an item upon which action may be taken by the Board. Comments by the public may be limited to three minutes as a reasonable time, place, and manner restriction, but may not be limited upon viewpoint. If a member of the public is unable to attend the meeting in person and would like to provide public comment during the meeting through remote appearance, they can submit a request via email before the scheduled meeting to regulations@ccb.nv.gov to receive instructions to join the meeting remotely. The CCB is not responsible for technical difficulties a member of the public may experience in connecting to the meeting remotely. Comments by the public may be emailed to regulations@ccb.nv.gov by 5:00 p.m. the day before the scheduled meeting and include the commenter's full name. Content may be redacted due to inappropriate language. All written public comments shall, in their entirety, be included as part of the public record. Prior to the commencement and conclusion of a contested case or a quasi-judicial proceeding that may affect the due process rights of an individual, the Board may refuse to consider public comment regarding the matter pursuant to NRS 678A.560 and NCCR 4.080. In the event technical difficulties prevent these proceedings from being broadcast, the CCB, at its discretion, may conduct the meeting without the proceedings being broadcast.
