



## **Metric Item Catalog – Frequently Asked Questions**

### **What is the Metric Item Catalog?**

The Metric Item Catalog is an online catalog of cannabis and cannabis products sold at the State’s licensed dispensaries and consumption lounges. It provides the public with up-to-date and comprehensive product information, including certified lab analyses and product locations, supporting transparency and compliance within the industry.

### **How do I find an item in the catalog?**

Items can be searched using the search box in the catalog. Before beginning a search, the **State** filter should be set to Nevada. The catalog includes products from multiple states, and applying this filter helps ensure accurate results.

Additional filters, such as **Item Name**, **Item Category**, **License Number**, and **Package ID Number**, are currently displayed but not yet fully functional. At this time, searches using these criteria can still be performed by entering the relevant information in the **“Search Name, Category, License”** search box.

Metric is actively working to make these filters fully functional, and updates will be provided as they become available.

If a search returns a large number of results, users may refine the list by applying sorting options. Results can be sorted by **Relevancy**, **Name**, or **Category** using the controls located in the upper-right corner of the screen.

### **What items are available in the catalog?**

The catalog displays cannabis and cannabis products tracked in Metric that are available for purchase at licensed dispensaries and consumption lounges:

- Products are included if they have recorded sales within the last **180 days** and are still available for purchase at retail facilities. Products that have sold out and been marked as inactive by the facility will not appear. Metric is working to display products that are marked as inactive but still had sales within the last 180 days, and updates will be provided as they become available.

### Note:

Products may remain stored in the catalog for up to 365 days after their last recorded sale; however, they are typically not visible after 180 days without a new sale.

If a new sale occurs within the 365-day period, the product will reappear in the catalog. Products that have just been received by a retailer will not appear until the first sale is recorded.

- Products are automatically removed from the catalog **365 days after their last recorded sale.**

## What information is listed for a specific product?

For each product, the catalog may display:

- Product category (e.g., Marijuana Flowers/Buds, Non-Solvent Based Concentrate)
- Name of the cultivation or production facility that packaged the product
- Licensed dispensaries and consumption lounges carrying the product
- Product description\*
- Ingredients\*
- List of Metrc package ID numbers - unique identifiers assigned to each product package in Metrc, as displayed on the product packaging label
- Certificate of Analysis - a laboratory report detailing the product's tested potency, safety, and quality, linked to the specific package
- Product and package images\*

\*Information is provided by the originating cultivation or production facility. If any information is missing, it is due to the facility not fulfilling Item Catalog requirements.

## **How do I confirm that a Certificate of Analysis (COA) is associated with a specific product?**

To confirm that a COA corresponds to a specific product, compare the key identifiers on the product packaging label with those on the COA:

- For **usable cannabis** (e.g., flower, shake/trim), the **Batch Number** and **Lot Number** should match.
- For **cannabis products** (e.g., vape cartridges, rosin, infused edibles), the **Production Run Number** on the packaging should align with the COA.

## **Why are some products listed without retailers?**

Products without listed retailers or Metrc package ID numbers are older products included during the initial catalog import. These products are no longer available for purchase and will be automatically removed from the catalog **365 days after their last recorded sale**.
